Comments to the Author

I am not comfortable with the discussion of the data on page 10 ("shape of a hill") since there are much more professional ways of describing the outcome. Also, I am not clear that the differences in module content were adequately incorporated into the review of discussion responses since some content does not lead to rigorous discussion.

Reviewer: 2

Comments to the Author

This research has good potential but needs language revision. It needs to be rewritten in some paragraphs (e.g page 7 - 4.1) in a scientific language. The Discussion is good and detailed need to be focused and reorganized. The variables of this research are not stated clearly.

Review Language (syntax, grammar, spelling)

Page (3) line 44 refer to the name of the author.

Page (4) referring to the learning community it is better to relate this idea with Connectivism Theory.

Add more References to international work

Page (5) need to be written clearly.

Page (7) rewrite in a scientific style

Comments to the Author

Abstract

- Should not use abbreviation.

Introduction

- Should use full name in first appear of MOOC.

- Should be cited, not simply say something without any evidence "MOOCs have become strategic educational medium, as they are broadly affordable to all social levels of people interested in learning. A MOOC is a Massive Online Open Course. MOOCs were originally intended to be massive, that is, cater for very large numbers of students. It was online, that is, provided over the internet."

- In my point of view, research problem and aim should be appeared on the end of introduction.

LR

- Contradiction: starts with "Facilitators in cMOOCs do not need to be concerned about responding to the needs of individual students." Then ends with "Thus, the cMOOC needs constant interactions between ... between students and facilitators."???

- "Online learning usually uses an online learning platform, also known as Learning Management Systems (LMS). These are specifically designed to provide a range of interactions between instructors and students, and to support assessment and student records." Missing citation.

- "To maintain high levels of engagement, some interactions occur outside the online learning platform, as mentioned in some research" please provide these some research.

- Online or on-line? Please use standards.

- "apps" you should show to the reader this abbreviation refers to what.

Method

- "Autonomous Learning (Module One), Digital Literacy (Module Two), Mobile Devices (Module Three), Video Use for Autonomous Learning (Module Four), and Making Videos for Teaching (Module Five). Module tasks included discussions (20%), movies (17%), projects (14%), peer reviews (8%), and multiple choice questions (6%)." these modules and percentage based on what?

- "The percentage of IMOOC completion in 2018 was higher than other MOOCs" what is the other MOOCs?

Findings

- I could not find how you collected the facilitators opinion (supposed to be mentioned in the method part) and why you divided the findings in three categories.

Discussion

- "The findings of this study tend to confirm previous research." Please list the previous research.

- "Several factors might explain the unequal quality of facilitators" please list these factors.

- In my point of view, discussion part should discuss the results. However, I think all thing is there in discussion part, but they are messy. These two parts (findings and discussion) need to be restructure.

References

- Almost half of the references are journals. I think journals can provide up-to-dated information so you should use more. Moreover, there is absence of reputable and well-known journals in e-learning field which concern as BIG limitation in your study.

In general, I cannot understand why you ran your study (research problem is not clear).

Reviewer: 4

Comments to the Author

I reviewed and found following ones:

1- In the Introduction section there is no theoretical background about MOOC's influence on human learning. On the other hand, there are many research which note opposite results. I suggested the author(s) to read Susan Greenfield, prominent cognitive neurologist.

2- I did not manage to understand how the research was designed, Qualitative research tradition or quantitative research tradition?. Moreover, how the data were collected although contents of the MOOC was explained in a clear way. Ethical consideration was not addressed that is a big shame I think. There is no information about how the participants were recruited into research sample and demographic information (such as age, sex). In addition to that, how the data were analyzed was not mentioned in the text.

3- Findings of the research were reported by mentioning previously conducted research. I think it could have discussed through a social science theory.
